The Clinic has a 76-year history and is now staffed with three outstanding board-certified primary-care physicians, who specialize in emergency medicine, family practice, and internal medicine. Our incredible doctors, nurses, medical assistants, radiology technician, and administrative staff are what makes the Clinic such a valuable asset to the Island.

Boca Grande Health Clinic Highlights:

- 6,000 Patient visits a year
- 415 X-Rays performed
- 5,000 COVID-19 tests
- 1,500 Flu shots
- 5,250 COVID-19 vaccinations and boosters
- Three full-time physicians
- Four Registered Nurses
- One Licensed Practical Nurse
- Two Medical Assistants
- One X-Ray Technician
